

Amendments and enlargement of roof extension approved under ref: 2024/0064 to include two French door openings and outdoor terrace with 1.1m screen in connection with use of the building as 3 x 2 bed flats and 1 x 1 bed flat (in conjunction with approved applications 2024/0064, 2024/1210)"

Current accommodation for the ground floor comprises of a vacant commercial unit, basement, reception room, WC with wash hand basin, shower room and kitchen with doors leading to a secluded private rear garden. Upstairs features a spacious kitchen/dining room, three piece bathroom suite and two space reception rooms/bedrooms. The top floor offers three further bedrooms and a three piece bathroom suite.
