The property is situated in this popular tree-lined road on the park side of East Sheen, a short walk from the main Sheen shopping centre and just over half a mile from Mortlake Railway Station, with its service to Clapham Junction and Waterloo. The Sheen Gate to Richmond Park is approximately a quarter of a mile away whilst Palewell Common is within 100 metres. There are many excellent schools in the general vicinity including St. Paul's, Tower House, Istock Place, The German and Swedish Schools, Colet Court and numerous first rate State Primary Schools.

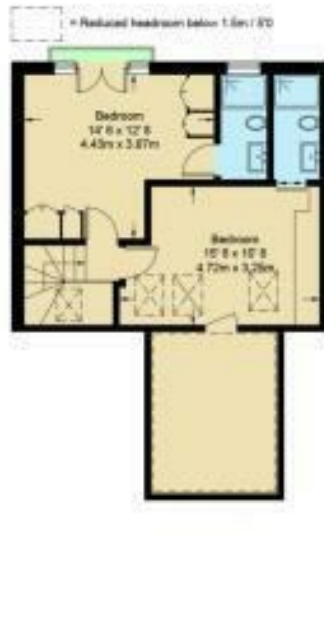
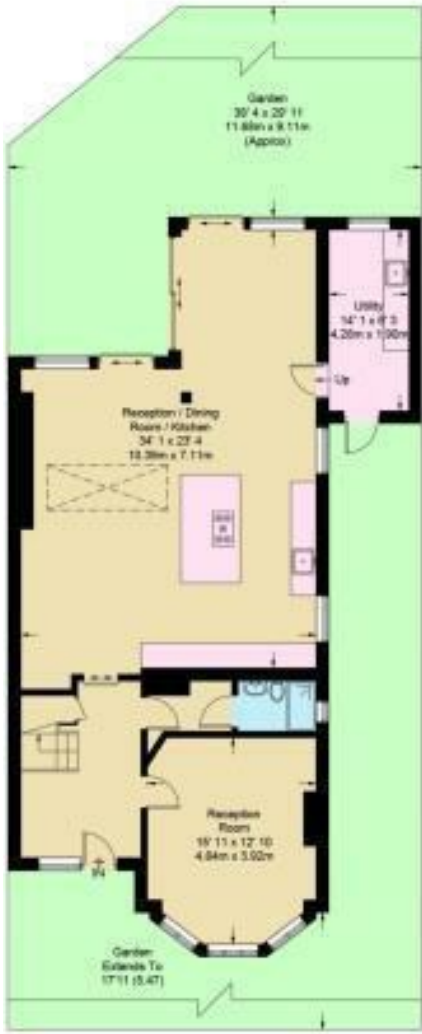
